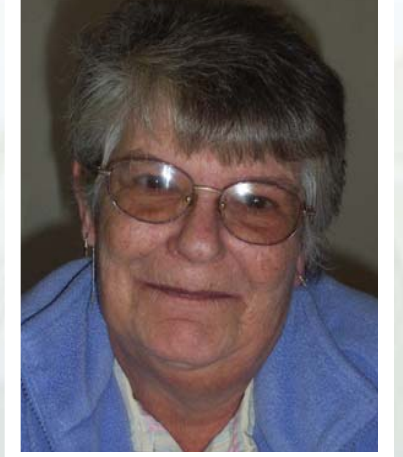

THE STORY OF WWIN



Julia Love Pritt

July 29, 1932 - April 3, 2010

The story of WWIN starts with Julia Pritt. Julia's personal story inspires many of us associated with WWIN, including many of WWIN's grantees. After recovering from a series of devastating personal losses (including the end of her marriage and cancer diagnosis and treatment), she found her life's purpose in helping others, including by founding Washington Women In Need in 1992. As of June 2010, WWIN has provided life changing grants for health care and education to more than 4800 low income women in Washington.

Julia guided this organization as board president and board member for many years. One of the paramount goals was that it would grow and mature so that more women could receive health care and education grants each year and for decades to come. She stepped down from the board in 2002 as an acknowledgment that the organization was strong and steady. Julia felt privileged to be in a position to give WWIN its wings. In May 2007 the organization received the Eastside Nonprofit of the Year Award from the Bellevue Chamber of Commerce. We are so pleased that Julia was at that event.

Julia was a compassionate philanthropist and she was also an astute and successful businesswoman. She started Attachmate Corporation with her husband at the time

and headed its accounting and human services departments until 1990. Her contributions to the growth of Attachmate were instrumental in its being acknowledged as one of the most successful privately held software companies in Washington.

Her foresight and business skills informed every aspect of the founding of Washington Women In Need. This is one of the reasons that WWIN's fundamental elements including its mission, vision and values, and its grant structure have remained virtually unchanged, even as the board of directors periodically reassesses the organization.

Julia passed away on April 3, 2010. We felt fortunate to be able to be with the WWIN community at the Bellevue Spring Benefit on May 6 to add a special piece to the event in honor of Julia. Kathleen Miller, long time board member, read from Julia's luncheon speech in 2002 where she shared her belief in the value of WWIN:

"Starting WWIN has been one of the most rewarding experiences of my life because I know that the women we help will not have to endure the pain of losing all their teeth, they will not have the frustration of not being able to see clearly, they will not be misunderstood or withdraw into themselves because they cannot hear, they will have the comfort that comes from having insurance and a counselor to talk to in times of stress. But most important of all they will get the education they need in order to support themselves and their families."

Her words, and the presence of her son and daughter in law Darren and Janine Pritt at the event, inspired us to heed her call to "join us... and help WWIN reach its next goal". We are grateful to Julia for giving us the opportunity to participate in this compassionate and empowering organization and for providing us with the vision, skills and resources to continue its mission, even though she is no longer with us. Thank you for your part in honoring Julia's legacy this past year as together we continue to improve the lives of low income women, one woman at a time, for years to come. As Julia said in 2002 "it is rewarding work."

EDUCATION GRANT

WWIN provided 62 additional women with Education Grants this fiscal year.

WWIN provides two years of tuition and books for eligible women and many women are receiving education grants this year but they are not counted in this total.

Tanya had an enviable life back in 1994. She was attending a prestigious college and was a published author in the neuroscience field. During that time she began experiencing some troubling symptoms. She was eventually diagnosed with schizophrenia and had to withdraw from her studies. Nine years later, after numerous hospitalizations, she felt ready to return to school; this time in the social services field. WWIN helped fund her tuition and books and allowed her to complete her Bachelor's Degree.

This grant covers the cost of books and tuition for up to 2 years, up to \$5,000 each year. WWIN clients often are returning to school after many years away, are working as they go to school, or raising a family, are seeking education to break into a new field, or a combination of all of these. Some of these non traditional education clients were homemakers for years and have recently found themselves with no marketable job skills. They show tremendous courage when they seek help to get the education to help fulfill their dreams and provide for themselves and their families.

Highlight: This year the Education Grant Application was available online. WWIN recognizes that women attending college must have access to a computer so it is appropriate that an online application is used for this grant area (and only this grant area). WWIN has also signed on with www.TheWashBoard.org, aware of the WWIN grant.

COUNSELING GRANT

In the 2009-2010 fiscal year, WWIN provided 196 low income women with these key counseling grants.

When Barbara applied for the WWIN counseling grant she was dealing with the recent loss of her mother, separation from her husband, and joblessness. With the grant, Barbara was able to choose a therapist to provide the help she wanted and needed. "I feel my strength coming back and I'm growing stronger daily..."

The WWIN Counseling Grant pays for up to 24 sessions of therapy within one year with a licensed therapist of the client's choice. Each grant recipient can decide how to utilize the 24 sessions, whether to attend weekly, twice monthly, or some combination thereof. She is also able to choose individual or group therapy. For many WWIN grantees the counseling grant is an important first step toward learning the tools to create a much better life for the long term.

Highlight: The 2010 luncheons featured former counseling grant recipient Stephanie, now working on her dissertation for her PhD after receiving a masters degree in psychology from Seattle Pacific University. As she said, "at 26 years of age I have a wonderful life ahead of me thanks to the donors of Washington Women In Need. But it wasn't always so." It was a riveting accounting of how getting the counseling grant saved her life.

HEALTH INSURANCE PREMIUMS (IP GRANT)

In 2009-2010 WWIN paid insurance premiums as well as co-pays and deductible expenses for 17 women.

Sandra was a nursing student who was required to maintain health insurance. She was struggling to juggle the catastrophic insurance premium with other basic needs. With the IP grant she was able to continue her medical insurance and visit a doctor and receive medical treatment that she wouldn't have been able to afford.

WWIN will pay a maximum of 12 months or \$4,000 in premiums and up to \$1,000 in co-pays, co-insurance, and deductible expenses.

A number of our health insurance premium clients have insurance through COBRA benefits. They have been laid off and are unable to pay the high premiums. Most express hope that they will secure new employment before the grant is complete.

Though this grant is a very small percentage of the budget, it can have a direct life-saving impact. Some of the grantees had to leave jobs due to a serious illness that requires on-going treatment – treatment they can receive with assistance from WWIN.

Highlight: This fiscal year we have grant openings once a month to better meet the rising demand for insurance assistance in a timely fashion.

PHYSICAL, DENTAL, VISION AND HEARING (PDVH GRANT)

In the 2009-2010 fiscal year, WWIN provided 83 women with this grant.

In the fall of 2009, Leslie had a choice to make, "Either die from infection, remove some teeth, or go further into debt." Leslie reported that she had been a successful real estate broker until she had begun to advise her clients to avoid sub-prime home loans, causing her to lose her job. She was pleased to find work helping students with special needs. However the position didn't provide medical benefits, and she didn't make enough money to pay for the dental work she so desperately needed. She finally received the dental and endodontic care she needed with the help of the WWIN PDVH grant.

The PDVH grant is in great demand, as there is very little comprehensive low-cost dental support available to women in Washington. This grant provides up to \$3,000 for approved medical services including comprehensive restorative dental and basic vision, hearing, and physical screening exams.

When a woman's teeth are in poor shape it affects many aspects of their life. It may be difficult to eat and sleep due to pain, and she may feel physically ill or be malnourished. Women often find employers unwilling to hire them. Women with dental issues or those who can not see or hear well may suffer from poor self-esteem and experience depression and isolation.

Highlight: WWIN developed a new system to handle the large number of applicants for this grant. Periodically WWIN provides a dedicated telephone number for a two day period where all potentially eligible applicants may call to provide the required information.



from the grant reserve fund, the Board of Directors established a budget in excess of \$750,000 for grants for the 2010-2011 year to respond to increasing demand.

The Challenge Ahead. With budget cuts affecting many education and health care programs benefiting low income women proposed at the state and federal level we expect to see a further rise in demand. Simply put, WWIN needs to raise even more money this year.

I can't solve the budget problems but I can do my part to honor Julia's legacy. I decided to make early payment on my multiyear pledge and to dig deep and make an additional gift this year so that I can contribute to our goal of increasing the grants available to women next year. Investing in women, one woman at a time. Would you help us meet this challenge?

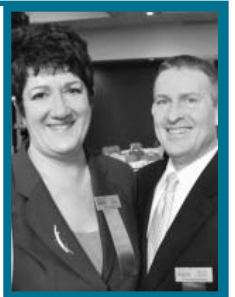
